In 1900 - 8 bells; 1937 - 10 bells

From Tower Captain Mr. Denis F. Willcocks - Bell nos. 5,6,7,8,9, & Tenor cast  
in 1874. Wooden frame. Two more added in same year (Bells 3 & 4 of present 10)  
Two more bells added in 1920 and iron frame fitted and bells 1 & 4 were hung  
in this, remaining 8 in 1874 wooden frame. Bells 7,8,9,10 given in memor of  
Arthur George George. All bells rehung in 1962 with no 3 recast. Service Bell  
came from Weld Chapel which stood adjacent to present Church, cast in 1616 and

inscribed THE GVIFTE OF THE LADYE IOANE BROOKE, weighs about ~~11~~ 2½ cwt.

were cast at Whitechapel Bell Foundry, London *Reverse side of leaflet gives details of  
clock and chime. Reported April 86 peel boards signatures required*

From "The Ringing World" 14.6.1974:- The bell from the Weld Chapel dates from 1616 and bears the  
marks of William Carter and Thomas Bartlett of Whitechapel foundry.

Treble and fourth in a new 1920 steel and iron frame on the north side of the tower, remaining  
bells hung in sturdy oak frame from 1874.
