ASHFORD St Matthew

The five bells are rung in full circle from the first floor.

Access to the ringing room is via a stone staircase located in the north-west corner. The ringing room is small with a medium high ceiling of 13 feet. There is a small window on the south side. The belfry is located on the second floor of the tower accessed by an iron ladder.

The four heaviest bells are hung in a low level cast iron four-bell frame on rolled steel joists installed in 1914 whilst the treble is accommodated on a grillage of rolled steel universal beams at high level.
