

## CITY, ST LAWRENCE JEWRY

The tower is at the west end of the church, built between 1671 and 1680. The bells are rung from the first floor. Access via a clockwise stone spiral staircase in the south east corner. (Clock room? – check). A continuation of the staircase gives access to the belfry. The bells are hung on one level on ball bearings.

The eight bells are rung in full circle.
