Order from H D Davenport, Hon. Sec., Building Fund Committee, St Mary's Church Ealing: 16", lever. Whitechapel Foundry day book 121

Sunday January 28 1798. Society of College Youths. 6048 Bob Major in 3h 45 m, with the sixth at Home 12 times Wrong [text omitted?] and 12 times Right in 54 courses. James Bartlett, James Brown, William Kirke, William Jones, John Langley, John Stratford, Charles Barber, William Paris. Peal called by J Bartlett. Mr Richard Rickman [or Hickman?] Mr Thomas Cracknell Churchwardens. Peal board [?]

A Friendly Society. Sunday May 2<sup>nd</sup> 1841. 5040 Grandsire Tripples in 3h 1m. R Howarth, G Stockham, C Balle, R Graham, W Jeffrys, T Tolladay © T Phillips Two ringers for the tenor: J Durant and W Hill. Rev. J Smith Vicar, Si Knevitt and Ts Layton Churchwardens. Peal board.

Bells here in 1552. 16" by R Phelps of Whitechapel believed to have been cast about 1729, did duty in the temporary tabernacle before the rebuilding in 1738; as the old church fell down in 1729 it probably dates from about that year. In 1754 it was hung as a clock bell in the cupola.
