

GOSPEL OAK. Sources

1865-6. Tower: four turrets removed after bomb damage in 2nd World War. C Hibbert *London's churches* p. 130

Consecrated 3/12/1865. Tower on north. J D Allcroft of Stokesay Court, Salop, provided money for the church to be built. E B Lamb architect. B F L Clarke *Parish churches of London*

Cast by Warners of Cripplegate in 1865. Each bell carries the Warner crest and an inscription:

- 1 Time flies
- 2 Call to prayer
- 3 Call to praise
- 4 John D Allcroft gave us
- 5 Live to God's Glory
- 6 Let all be joyful. From information sheet, also *Ringing world* January 25th 1980 p.65 (cover article)

"Tenor c 12 ½ cwt and that all six bells were cast by J Warner in 1873 [sic]" are the only details from *Schedule of bells*
