

HARROW WEALD

The semi-detached south tower is built a little east of the west end of the church with a tiled red roof.

In 1935 the six largest bells were tuned and all eight bells rehung in a new 'H' type steel and iron frame on one level. The bells are mounted on cast iron headstocks fitted with self-aligning ball bearings, traditional wheels and clappers and Hastings type stays.

The eight bells are rung in full circle.
