

PIMLICO, ST GABRIEL

The tower is situated at the west end of the north-west corner of the church which was designed by Thomas Cundy in 1852/3.

Access to the first floor ringing room is via a stone staircase located in the north-east corner of the tower. This room is large with a medium high ceiling of about 12 ft. and with one window.

The belfry is located on the third floor accessed via a continuation of the main staircase.

The timber frame occupies the whole space in which the bells are hung, on one level, with plain bearings and wooden headstocks.

The bells are rung in full circle.
