

CITY, ST ANDREW, HOLBORN CIRCUS

The present bells are hung in a new cast iron 8-bell frame.
The bells are rung in full circle.

Mostly dictated by Steve 11.11.2004

Access by stone spiral staircase in the south-west corner of the tower. As the floor has been raised the entry is gained by stepping down three steps. Spiral stone clockwise staircase to the first floor ringing room approximately 18ft in height.

The chain of the candelabra goes through the trap doors of the ceiling and the floor of the ringing room. The clock room is on the second floor. Continuance of the staircase gives access to the belfry on the 3rd floor.
