

## ST GEORGE IN THE EAST

All the inscriptions are at the waist

With the exception of the 2<sup>nd</sup> bell all the bells have the foundry stamp on the reverse side to the main inscription. The foundry stamp consists of the three bells (two above one) with the founders initials AAH (top left), WAH (top right) and DH (centre bottom).
