

HAREFIELD

Access to the ringing room is via stone steps to the first floor literally a few feet above ground level. The ringing room is small with a medium high ceiling. It has a small leaded window from which can be seen who is using the main approach to the church.

A ladder gives access to the belfry on the second floor

The bells are on one tier and hang in a steel 'A' frame installed in 1963.

The 5th bell is with canon retaining headstock.

The six bells are rung in full circle.
