

## CITY, ST VEDAST

Tower is at the west end of the church. Access is internal in the north-west corner of the tower. Access is by a stone spiral clockwise staircase. The bells are rung from the first floor. On the south and west sides of the ringing room there is a balustrade because the floor does not extend as there is a window. The staircase continues to provide access to the intermediate chamber and the belfry on the third floor. The bells are hung on one level in a wooden frame with modern fittings.

The six bells are rung in full circle.
