The tower is on the south side of the church

The access to the ringing chamber is unusual – a climb of a long, wooden, almost vertical ladder, next to the organ loft. This room accommodates the chiming apparatus.

The new bells and fittings were installed in the timber low sided frame installed in 1875. **VP: Check this statement.**

The bells are hung on one level on ball bearings.

The six bells are rung in full circle
