

TWICKENHAM, ALL HALLOWS

The tower is adjacent to the west end corner of the church.

Access to the first floor ringing room is via stone staircase located in the north east corner of the tower. This room is large with a medium high false ceiling of 20 ft. high about 2 ft. below floor above. There is one window in the south wall.

The belfry is located on the second floor accessed via a metal ladder attached to the wall.

There is enough space to walk round three sides of the metal frame. The bells are hung on one level with roller bearings. All the bells have metal headstocks.

A trap-door opens to the floor above which room contains the louvres.

The bells are rung in full circle.

The Sanctus bell is one floor above the ring of ten bells. It is hung dead in the middle of the room 15 ft. above the floor. Inscription and weight unknown, it is similar in size to the treble bell. Four bolts to cross beam
